Hazard: Illegal or excessive residues in harvested crop may cause lack of market opportunity	Preventive measure: Farmers must only use approved registered pesticides strictly according to the label	Critical control point (CCP): Selection of pre-harvest chemicals	
Critical limit: All pre-harvest pesticides should be undetectable in the crop at harvest unless specifically authorised	Monitoring: Check regulations each year before sowing	Corrective action: Commodity must be sent for residue analysis if mistake has occurred but it may still be necessary to suspend/alter sale	
Verification/records: Farmer should maintain record of actions taken for possible verification	Where to look: See discussion of pre-harvest residues and testing .
