<b>Task 4: Pre-harvest pesticide selection</b>		
<b>Hazard:</b> Illegal or excessive residues in harvested crop may cause lack of market opportunity	<b>Preventive measure:</b> Farmers must only use approved registered pesticides strictly according to the label	<b>Critical control point (CCP):</b> Selection of pre-harvest chemicals
<b>Critical limit:</b> All pre-harvest pesticides should be undetectable in the crop at harvest unless specifically authorised	<b>Monitoring:</b> Check regulations each year before sowing	<b>Corrective action:</b> Commodity must be sent for residue analysis if mistake has occurred but it may still be necessary to suspend/alter sale
<b>Verification/records:</b> Farmer should maintain record of actions taken for possible verification	<b>Where to look:</b> See discussion of pre-harvest residues and testing <a href="#">□</a> .
