Soil Probe Demonstration

Tim Powell of Integrated Irrigation will demonstrate the full range of features from the soil probes rolled out to Wimmera farmers through the CMA, with a focus on how farmers can easily access and apply the data.

Using soil moisture data for better decisions

Agriculture Victoria Seasonal Risk Agronomist Dale Boyd will share how soil probe data can support better crop and pasture decisions this spring. He will provide an update of the soil moisture profiles in the Wimmera and present key indicators from the datasets to maximise the benefits from investment in this technology.
